## ALTERATIONS IN THE BOUNDARIES OF IMPROVEMENT DISTRICTS NOS. 124\_125 and 129

Whereas under the provisions of section 4 of The Improvement Districts Act, the Minister of Municipal Affairs may, by order, notice of which shall be published in *The Alberta Gazette*,

(a) direct that any improvement district shall cease to be such; or

(b) alter the boundaries of any improvement district by way of addition thereto or subtraction therefrom; or

(c) amalgamate any two or more districts; or

(d) alter the name or number of any improvement district; and

Whereas it is deemed advisable and in the best public interest that the boundaries of certain improvement districts should be changed;

Now, therefore, the undersigned, by virtue of the authority vested in me by section 4 of The Improvement Districts Act, do hereby order:

That the boundaries of Improvement District No. 124 shall be altered by adding thereto the following land:

All those portions of township 73, ranges 5 to 13 inclusive, and all of township 74, ranges 5 to 13 inclusive, covered by the waters of Lesser Slave Lake, west of the fifth meridian.

That the boundaries of Improvement District No. 125 shall be altered by adding thereto the following land:

All those portions of townships 74 and 75, range 14, and that portion of township 75, range 15, covered by the waters of Lesser Slave Lake, west of the fifth meridian.

That the boundaries of Improvement District No. 129 shall be altered by withdrawing therefrom the following land:

All of township 74, range 5, and those portions of township 74, range 6, not covered by the waters of Lesser Slave Lake, west of the fifth meridian,

and by adding thereto the following land:

All those portions of township 75, ranges 6 to 12 inclusive, covered by the waters of Lesser Slave Lake, all west of the fifth meridian.

That this order shall become effective on the 1st day of April, 1956. Dated at Edmonton in the Province of Alberta, this 17th day of April, 1956.
