HAMLET OF HIGH LEVEL TO BE KNOWN AS THE NEW TOWN
OF HIGH LEVEL

Edmonton, Tuesday, June 1, 1965.

Whereas an application has been received, pursuant to section 4(1) of The New Towns Act, being chapter 39 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1956, as amended by the Provincial Planning Board for establishment of the Hamlet of High Level as a new town to be known as the New Town of High Level; and

Whereas it is deemed desirable and expedient to provide for the establishment of a new town:

Therefore, upon the recommendation of the Honourable the Minister of Municipal Affairs, the Executive Council advises that, pursuant to section 3 of The New Towns Act:

(1) The area of the New Town of High Level shall be as follows:

In township 109, range 19, west of the fifth meridian:

North-east quarter of section 29,

West half of section 29,

Sections 30, 31, 32,

West half of section 33,

North-east quarter of section 33,

North-west quarter of section 34.

In township 110, range 19, west of the fifth meridian:

West half of section 3,

Sections 4, 5 and 6.

(2) The following persons be and are hereby appointed Members of the Board of Administrators of the New Town of High Level:

Albert A. McLarty—Businessman, High Level

Donald F. Edgar—Public Servant of the Province

Leonard L. Gurel—Public Servant of the Province

(3) The said Alberta A. McLarty be and is hereby appointed Chairman of the said Board.
