NEW TOWN OF SWAN HILLS ESTABLISHED

Edmonton, Tuesday, August 18, 1959.

The Executive Council has had under consideration the report of the Honourable the Minister of Municipal Affairs, dated August 11th, 1959, stating that:

Whereas various companies undertaking works in the Swan Hills oil field have requested the establishment of a permanent townsite to serve the area; and

Whereas many members of the public have expressed a desire to establish themselves in various businesses, trades or professions and to build houses in such a community; and

Whereas the Provincial Planning Advisory Board, after holding public hearings in the matter, receiving submissions from companies operating in the area and receiving reports of surveys undertaken by the Department of Lands and Forests and Municipal Affairs, and after considering the matter, made certain recommendations with regard thereto; and

Whereas it is deemed desirable and expedient to provide for the establishment of a new town in the said area;

Therefore, upon the recommendation of the Honourable the Minister of Municipal Affairs, the Executive Council advises that pursuant to the provisions of section 3 of The New Towns Act, being chapter 39 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1956, as amended:

(1) The area described as follows:

Legal subdivisions 4, 5, 12 and 13 of section 13; the whole of section 14; legal subdivisions 1 and 8, 9 and 16 of section 15; legal subdivisions 1 and 8 of section 22; south half $(S.\frac{1}{2})$ of section 23; legal subdivisions 4 and 5 of section 24. All of the above described lands lying within township 66, range 10, west of the fifth meridian, be and is hereby declared a new town to be known as the New Town of Swan Hills.

(2) The establishment of the New Town shall be effective as, on and from the 1st day of September, 1959.
