NEW TOWN OF WHITECOURT FORMED INTO THE TOWN OF WHITECOURT

The Executive Council has had under consideration the report of the Honourable the Acting Minister of Municipal Affairs, dated November 5, 1971, stating that:

Whereas pursuant to section 5 of The New Towns Act, the New Town of Whitecourt was incorporated by Order in Council numbered O.C. 1253/61 effective August 15, 1961; and

Whereas a written request that the New Town of Whitecourt be formed into a Town has been received from the Board of Administrators of the New Town of Whitecourt; and

Whereas the New Town has repaid in full all advances of money obtained from the Provincial Treasurer pursuant to section 19 of The New Towns Act:

Therefore, upon the recommendation of the Honourable the Acting Minister of Municipal Affairs, the Executive Council advises that the Lieutenant Governor in Council, pursuant to section 22 of The New Towns Act, do order as follows:

1. The New Town of Whitecourt is hereby formed into the Town of Whitecourt effective December 20, 1971;

2. The boundaries of the Town of Whitecourt, being those set out in Order in Council numbered O.C. 1253/61, are hereby established as follows:

The north half of section 19, sections 29, 30, 31 and 32, all in township 59, range 11, west of the fifth meridian and the north half of section 24 and sections 25, 26, 34, 35 and 36, all in township 59, range 12, west of the fifth meridian and all road allowances and surveyed roads lying between or in the sections as hereinbefore set out;

3. The Board of Administrators of the New Town of Whitecourt shall cease to hold office upon the date that the Council of the Town of Whitecourt is sworn into office.
