The Executive Council has had under consideration the report of the Honourable the Minister of Municipal Affairs, dated August 14th, 1961, stating that:

WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Whitecourt has pursuant to section 4 of The New Towns Act made application to the Provincial Planning Advisory Board for the establishment of the Village of Whitecourt and environs as a new town; and

WHEREAS the Provincial Planning Advisory Board after holding a public hearing in the matter and receiving submissions from property owners in the immediate area and other persons and authorities concerned with the application and after considering the application, have made certain recommendations with regard thereto; and

WHEREAS it is deemed desirable and expedient to provide for the establishment of a new town in the said area:

THEREFORE, upon the recommendation of the Honourable the Minister of Municipal Affairs, the Executive Council advises that, pursuant to the provisions of section 3 of The New Towns Act, being chapter 39 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1956, as amended:

- (1) The North half of Section 19 and Sections 29, 30, 31 and 32 all in Township 59, Range 11, West of the Fifth Meridian; and The North half of Section 24 and Sections 25, 26, 34, 35 and 36 all in Township 59, Range 12, West of the Fifth Meridian; and All road allowances and surveyed roads lying between or in the Sections as hereinbefore set out, be and are hereby declared to be a new town to be known as the NEW TOWN OF WHITECOURT.

- (2) The membership of the Board of Administrators of the New Town of Whitecourt shall be as follows:

Chairman - Clyde M. Feero	- businessman of the Village of Whitecourt
Allen J. Millar	- businessman of the Village of Whitecourt
Albert Nelson	- businessman of the Village of Whitecourt
William D. Isbister	- Assistant, Chief Municipal Inspector, Department of Municipal Affairs
Leonard L. Gurel	- Senior Municipal Inspector, Department of Municipal Affairs.

- (3) Each of the members of the Board of Administrators who is not a public servant shall be paid an allowance of \$10.00 per day for each day that he attends a meeting of the Board, provided that he shall not be paid for more than twelve meetings in any one year.
- (4) The establishment of the New Town of Whitecourt shall be effective as, on and from the 15th day of August, 1961.
