



**Information to file complaints on linear property assessments for the 2016 tax year**

**The deadline for filing a complaint** on linear property assessments is 60 days from the date the assessment notice is sent and appears on the linear property assessment notice.

**Complaints** about linear property assessments must be filed **with the Administrator of the Municipal Government Board**<sup>1</sup>.

**Filing complaints and complaint fees** are pursuant to section 18 of the *Matters Relating to Assessment Complaints Regulation*<sup>2</sup>.

- 18(1) If a complaint is to be heard by the Municipal Government Board, the complainant must
  - (a) complete and file with the administrator a complaint containing the information set out in section 19, and
  - (b) pay the appropriate complaint fee set out in Schedule 2 at the time the complaint is filed.
- (2) If a complainant does not comply with subsection (1),
  - (a) the complaint is invalid, and
  - (b) the Municipal Government Board must dismiss the complaint.

**Complaint fees**, as listed in Schedule 2 of the *Matters Relating to Assessment Complaints Regulation*<sup>2</sup>, are as follows:

Category of Complaint	Complaint Fee	
Linear property-power generation	Flat fee	\$650 per facility
Linear property-other	Flat fee	\$ 50 per LPAUID *
