Introduction

This guide is provided to assist your company in understanding your 2016 linear property assessment notice (for the 2017 tax year) and related fields and columns.

The format for the linear property assessment notice is the same for all seven property types:

- Pipeline (Alberta Energy Regulator (AER), Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC), National Energy Board(NEB)/Self-Reported)
- Well
- Electric Power Generation
- Electric Power Transmission and Distribution
- Cable Distribution Undertakings
- Telecommunication Carrier
- Gas Distribution

Although the format is the same for all seven types, the contents of the fields on the assessment notice may show different information.

Consequently, you will need to refer to the 2016 Alberta Linear Property Assessment Minister's Guidelines when reviewing the specific details of your company's assessment. A copy of this document can be found at:
