Elevating Devices, Passenger Ropeways and Amusement Rides Permit Regulation AR286/2002

Certificate of Construction Permit Duration of Validation Requirements

Authority:

Section 44(2) of the Safety Codes Act gives a safety codes officer the authority to include terms and conditions in a permit.

Consistent with the provisions of the *Government Organization Act*, and the Elevating Devices Administration Regulation, the delegation of the functions of the safety codes officer have been delegated to the Alberta Elevating Devices and Amusement Rides Safety Association (AEDARSA).

Notification:

Pursuant to section 44(2) of the Safety Codes Act, the following Certificate of Construction Permit Duration of Validation condition is included in a Certificate of Construction Permit:

This Certificate of Construction Permit is valid for 24 months from the date it is issued. If the construction of the device named in this certificate has not been completed within the 24-month time frame, the permit holder must apply to AEDARSA for a new certificate of construction permit or have this certificate reinstated.

Background:

Alberta Municipal Affairs, in consultation with the Safety Codes Council (Elevator Technical Council), establishes policy regarding the duration that a Certificate of Construction Permit may remain valid.
