Transfer of the Master Electrician Program

The Master Electrician Program (MEP) will be transferred to the Safety Codes Council from the Electrical Contractors Association of Alberta effective May 1, 2011. With this move, all aspects of MEP including examinations, certifications, renewals and other correspondence fall under the Safety Codes Council.

This transition is consistent with the Safety Codes Council's mandate to deliver certification and training services. Under the Safety Codes Council, the Administrator of the MEP will continue to have authority for managing the program, which includes evaluating applicants for Master Electrician certificates, marking exams, providing program advice and issuing and renewing certificates of competency.

The Safety Codes Council will notify Master Electricians in the near future with regard to renewals and information about the upcoming exam calendar during this time of transition.
